

About PACE



This fact sheet is about **PACE**.

PACE is a new NDIS system that is safe and easy to use.



PACE will make it easier to

see information about your NDIS plan




- see your NDIS budget
 - budget means money in your NDIS plan



 see the money spent on products and services



 pay for products and services – if you self manage your NDIS plan.



The **NDIA** will let you know when your NDIS plan is ready in PACE.

The NDIA is the agency that manages the NDIS.



When your NDIS plan is ready in PACE, you can go to a new **portal** called **My NDIS**.

A portal is like a website.

What you need to do



When your plan is ready in PACE, you will need to add your **service providers**.



Service providers are organisations that give services.

For example, Scope is a service provider.



If your NDIS budget is agency managed, please make sure Scope is added as a **My Provider**.



You can

 tell the NDIA planner to add Scope at your plan review meeting



 ask your support coordinator or your participant or plan nominee to help you contact the NDIA



- contact the NDIA yourself
 - call 1800 800 110
 - you can call early from 8:30 am.



If you use different Scope services

If you use different Scope services you will need to

• add a My Provider for each service



• add the right Scope name for each service.



If you use Scope and Home@Scope services in Victoria, you will need to add them as

- Scope (Aust) Ltd
- Home@Scope Pty Ltd



If you use Scope services in NSW, you will need to add them as

Disability Services Australia Ltd



If you use Scope support coordination services in NSW, you will need to add them as

• Scope (Aust) Ltd
