Children's Mobility Advisory Service



GoKids provides expert advice and support for children 0-18 years in regards to their mobility needs.

Devices include specialised walkers, standing frames, the David Hart Walker, manual and powered wheelchairs. GoKids is a state-wide service staffed by expert therapists.



GoKids can:

- Organise an assessment and trial of walkers, standing frames and wheelchairs.
- Provide a recommendation to the family about the most suitable equipment.
- Source quotes, assist with funding applications and place orders.
- Provide training in safety use and fitting of equipment.

GoKids can help:

- Children up to the age of 18 who live in Victoria (you do not have to be an existing Scope client).
- Families who are seeking specialist mobility advice for their child.
- Families who do not have a primary therapist to help them select the best equipment.
- Therapists who require advice from experienced staff about equipment and funding related issues.

How to Organise an Assessment:

A referral can be made to GoKids by a parent, therapist, carer or other key worker. Once the Referral Form has been received GoKids will be in contact to organise an assessment appointment at one of the GoKids offices.
