Co-presented by people with disabilities, our remote programs provide students with an opportunity to see everyday life through the eyes of people with a disability.

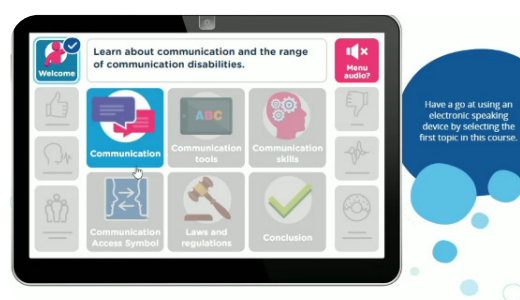
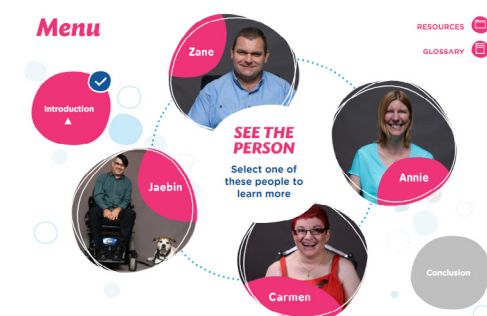
Students will come away from their learning experience with:
